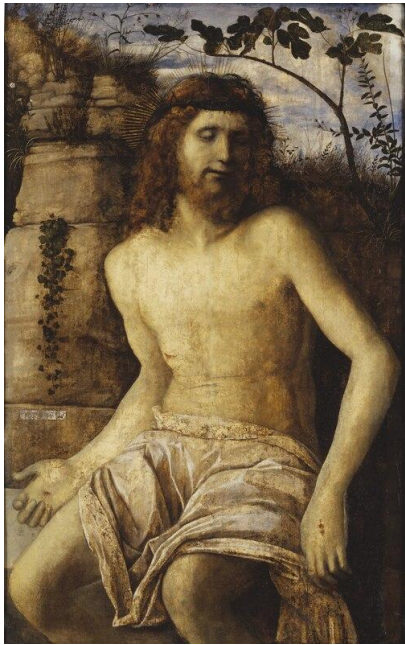


Deesis with saints, Novgorod, ca. 1400?

The National Museum has a fine collection of Renaissance and later European paintings



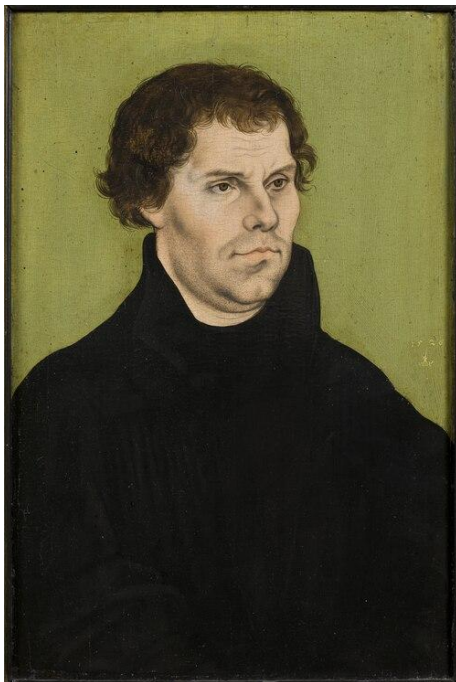
There are nine works by Rembrandt including *The Conspiracy of the Batavians under Claudius Civilis*, 1661. The largest painting he ever produced, measuring five by five meters. Now it is cut down to 196 cm × 309. It was intended for the Amsterdam Town Hall who rejected it.

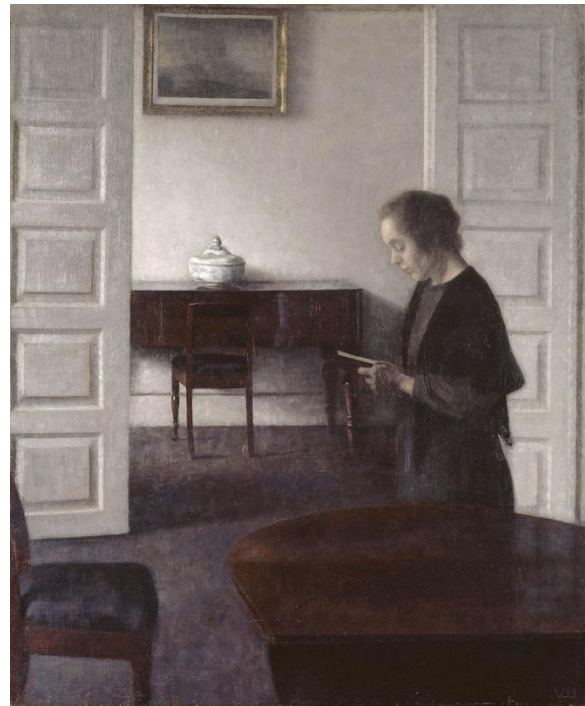
